Baltic states, also known as simply the Baltics, consist of three Northern Europe countries – Lithuania, Latvia and Estonia, the development of which is strongly influenced by the well-developed Scandinavian and Western European countries.

Lithuania, Latvia and Estonia became independent in 1990 – 1991 and do not form an official union; they all have their own languages (Lithuanian, Latvian and Estonian), capitals (Vilnius, Riga and Tallinn) and national identities. Though each individual country is considered rather small in the global context, the combined territory of the Baltic states amounts to 175 015 sq. km. with the population of around 6 million.

All three countries are members of the European Union and NATO.

LATVIA

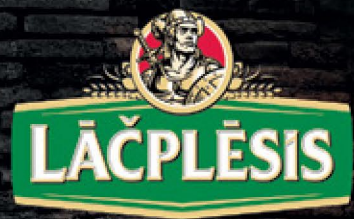
